

WHAT IS ZIONISM?

Zionism is the movement for the selfdetermination and statehood for the Jewish people (aka, the People of Israel) in their ancestral homeland, the land of Israel. (adl.org)

EXAMPLES OF ANTI-ZIONISM THAT ARE ANTI-JEWISH:

- Denying the Jewish people their right to selfdetermination, e.g., by claiming that the existence of the State of Israel is a racist endeavor.
- Applying double standards by requiring of Israel a behavior not expected or demanded of any other democratic nation.
- Drawing comparisons of contemporary Israeli policy to that of the Nazis. (International Holocaust Remembrance Alliance)

Organizations such as Hamas, The Palestinian Movement, Students for Justice in Palestine & Jewish Voice for Peace call for Israel's destruction.

OCCUPATION? NO

Israel does not occupy Gaza and hasn't since 2005. The status of the West Bank is complicated. Some consider it occupied; others consider it disputed. There are over 100 places around the world with territorial conflicts. Why don't we hear much about those other territorial conflicts?

GENOCIDE? NO

"Israel is not trying to wipe the Palestinian people off the map. Israel is not trying to wipe Gaza off the map. Israel is trying to defend itself against a genocidal terrorist threat [Hamas]. So if we're going to start using that word, let's use it appropriately." White House National Security Council spokesman John Kirby.

APARTHEID? NO

Israel has laws aimed at ensuring equality for all it's citizens. Representing over 20% of Israel's population, Israeli Arab citizens serve in the government, in the army and as journalists, professors, & artists, playing large roles in all aspects of society.

COLONIZATION? NO

Jews are indigenous to the land of Israel. There has been a continuous presence of Jews in the land for thousands of years.

COLLECTIVE PUNISHMENT? NO

War is awful. Hamas started the war. Israel is defending itself. Hamas uses people as shields and need to be held accountable.

PERFECT? NO

Israel has problems, just like any other country! Israeli citizens of all religions & ethnicities can vote and are working together to make Israel the best it can be!



JCRC-NM is guided by the following:

- The October 7th terror attacks were pure evil and can never be justified.
- Hamas should immediately release all the hostages without condition.
- Israel has the right to defend itself from Hamas and stop the terrorist threat Hamas poses to its citizens.
- Journalists and editorialists covering events in Israel and Gaza bear a responsibility to accurately characterize the atrocities committed by Hamas as terrorism and to distinguish between those brutal acts specifically targeting innocent civilians and Israel's efforts to target the terrorists and protect its citizens from further harm.
- Palestinian civilians in Gaza are also victims of Hamas which uses Palestinians as human shields and locates its terrorist operations in, among, and under schools, hospitals, apartment buildings and other civilian institutions.
- We support humanitarian relief for Palestinians in Gaza; realistic protections should be in place to ensure that Hamas does not divert critical supplies from innocent civilians to its own forces.
- We support a substantial security package for Israel and for humanitarian aid for Palestinians in Gaza as soon as possible.

• We believe there is still hope for peace between Palestinians and Israelis, but not while Hamas is in control of Gaza and has the capacity to continue to launch terror attacks against Israel.

• We are concerned about the rise in antisemitism in recent years including since the Israel-Hamas War. Jews are facing increasing danger throughout the world, not just in Israel.

• There is no place for antisemitism or other forms of hate in our communities and we will remain vigilant in supporting the safety and security of all New Mexicans.
